<p>What is the overall <a href="#">deductible</a>?</p>	<p>For <a href="#">in-network providers</a>: \$2,500/individual or \$5,000/family                      For <a href="#">out-of-network providers</a>: \$5,000/individual or \$15,000/family</p>	<p>Generally, you must pay all of the costs from <a href="#">providers</a> up to the <a href="#">deductible</a> amount before this <a href="#">plan</a> begins to pay. If you have other family members on the <a href="#">plan</a>, each family member must meet their own individual <a href="#">deductible</a> until the total amount of <a href="#">deductible</a> expenses paid by all family members meets the overall family <a href="#">deductible</a>.</p>
<p>Are there services covered before you meet your <a href="#">deductible</a>?</p>	<p>Yes. In-network <a href="#">preventive care</a> &amp; immunizations, office visits, <a href="#">prescription drugs</a>, preventive generic <a href="#">prescription drugs</a>, home delivery <a href="#">prescription drugs</a> are covered before you meet your <a href="#">deductible</a>.</p>	<p>This <a href="#">plan</a> covers some items and services even if you haven't yet met the <a href="#">deductible</a> amount. But a <a href="#">copayment</a> or <a href="#">coinsurance</a> may apply. For example, this <a href="#">plan</a> covers certain <a href="#">preventive services</a> without <a href="#">cost-sharing</a> and before you meet your <a href="#">deductible</a>. <p>What is the <a href="#">out-of-pocket limit</a> for this <a href="#">plan</a>?</p>	<p>For <a href="#">in-network providers</a> \$5,000/individual or \$10,000/family                      For <a href="#">out-of-network providers</a> \$10,000/individual or \$30,000/family                      For in-network <a href="#">prescription drugs</a> - \$1,600/individual or \$3,200/family</p>	<p>The <a href="#">out-of-pocket limit</a> is the most you could pay in a year for covered services. If you have other family members in this <a href="#">plan</a>, they have to meet their own <a href="#">out-of-pocket limits</a> until the overall family <a href="#">out-of-pocket limit</a> has been met.</p>
<p>What is not included in the <a href="#">out-of-pocket limit</a>?</p>	<p>Penalties for failure to obtain <a href="#">pre-authorization</a> for services, <a href="#">premiums</a>, <a href="#">balance-billing</a> charges, and health care this <a href="#">plan</a> doesn't cover.</p>	<p>Even though you pay these expenses, they don't count toward the <a href="#">out-of-pocket limit</a>.</p>

Will you pay less if you use a <a href="#">network provider</a> ?	Yes. See <a href="http://www.myCigna.com">www.myCigna.com</a> or call 1-800-Cigna24 for a list of <a href="#">network providers</a> .	This <a href="#">plan</a> uses a <a href="#">provider network</a> . You will pay less if you use a <a href="#">provider</a> in the <a href="#">plan's network</a> . You will pay the most if you use an <a href="#">out-of-network provider</a> , and you might receive a bill from a <a href="#">provider</a> for the difference between the <a href="#">provider's</a> charge and what your <a href="#">plan</a> pays ( <a href="#">balance billing</a> ). Be aware your <a href="#">network provider</a> might use an <a href="#">out-of-network provider</a> for some services (such as lab work). Check with your <a href="#">provider</a> before you get services.
Do you need a <a href="#">referral</a> to see a <a href="#">specialist</a> ?	No.	You can see the <a href="#">specialist</a> you choose without a <a href="#">referral</a> .

### **Your Grievance and Appeals Rights:**

### **Does this plan provide Minimum Essential Coverage? Yes**

If you don't have [Minimum Essential Coverage](#) for a month, you'll have to make a payment when you file your tax return unless you qualify for an exemption from the requirement that you have health coverage for that month.

### **Does this plan meet the Minimum Value Standards? Yes**

If your [plan](#) doesn't meet the [Minimum Value Standards](#), you may be eligible for a [premium tax credit](#) to help you pay for a [plan](#) through the [Marketplace](#).

**This is not a cost estimator.** Treatments shown are just examples of how this [plan](#) might cover medical care. Your actual costs will be different depending on the actual care you receive, the prices your [providers](#) charge, and many other factors. **Peg is Having a Baby**  
(9 months of in-network pre-natal care and a hospital delivery)
